TEXAS RETIRED MILITARY GOLF CLASSIC Bill McCollough Memorial Tournament

Dear Fellow Golfer:

The 41st annual Texas Retired Military Golf Classic/Bill McCollough Memorial Tournament has been scheduled for September 20 thru September 23, 2021. Registration will be on Monday, September 20th from Noon to 4 PM at the American Legion. The Tournament will be played at Hawks Creek Golf Course on Tuesday and Thursday, September 21st & 23rd and at Whitestone Golf Course on Wednesday, September 22nd.

The tournament format will be a four-person 18 hole scramble all three days. The field will be split into two divisions, if we have enough players, so that all golfers will be competing against others with like handicaps and skill level. The tournament is open to Retired Military, Active Duty Military, and Military Reserve personnel with more than 20 years of service, spouses of retirees, Military Veterans that are sponsored by a retired military member, and special invitations to Bill's close friends. The committee reserves the right to adjust handicaps as deemed necessary based on home course rating, slope, and past tournament play.

Your entry fee of \$250.00 (\$260.00 if you bring a guest to the socials) will cover course fees, carts, daily place money, and socials. Skins will not be played. Instead, all the available prize money will be folded into the place money. Each day will be a separate tournament. Cash prizes will be awarded for places 1 through 4 (possibly more places depending on number of players) on each course, each day. Prize money will be divided equally between the two divisions. Closest-to-the pin prize money will be paid on the third day at Hawks Creek. Payment will be by check mailed shortly after the conclusion of the tournament. The golf courses are currently operating normally. The golf courses will require riding two to a cart because of cart availability.

American Legion Post 626, 1125 Burton Hill Road, Ft Worth, TX 76114 will be tournament headquarters. As mentioned above, registration will on be on Monday and a Pork Chop Dinner/ Social will also be on Monday with social time starting at 4 and dinner served at 5. There will be a Special time to remember Bill McCollough and share stories after the round on Wednesday with an open bar as long as the money lasts. At the conclusion of the Hawks Creek round on Thursday afternoon, there will be an "After Tournament social" with drinks and heavy hors d'oeuvres at the American Legion.

There will be no acceptance letter—your cashed check will be your acceptance in the event. We hope to see you in Fort Worth in September.

If we receive sufficient entrants, there will be a ladies tournament at the Hawks Creek Golf Course on Wednesday, September 22nd. The entry fee for the ladies' tournament will be \$50.00 and will cover green fees, cart, and prizes, and may be in a separate check or included with the men's application.
