TEXAS RETIRED MILITARY GOLF CLASSIC Bill McCollough Memorial Tournament

Dear Fellow Golfer: June 7, 2022

The 42^{nd} annual Texas Retired Military Golf Classic / Bill McCollough Memorial Tournament has been scheduled for **22-25 August 2022** in Fort Worth, Texas. Registration Sign-In will be on Monday, August 22^{nd} from 12 Noon to 4 PM at the American Legion. The Tournament will be played at Hawks Creek Golf Club on Tuesday and Thursday, August 23^{rd} and 25^{th} and at Whitestone Golf Club on Wednesday, August 24^{th} .

The tournament is open to all Military -- Retired, Active Duty, Veterans, Reservists. Military spouses are also welcome to play as are Bill McCollough's close non-military friends.

The tournament format will remain a four-person 18 hole scramble all three days using A-B-C-D players determined by handicap. The teams will be formed at random. The field will be split into two divisions, if we have enough players, so that all golfers will be competing against others with like handicaps and skill level. The committee reserves the right to adjust handicaps as deemed necessary based on home course rating, slope, and past tournament play.

Your entry fee of \$260.00 (\$270.00 if you bring a guest to the socials) will cover course fees including practice balls on the driving range, carts, daily place and closest-to-the-pin money, and the two socials. Each day will be a separate tournament. Cash prizes will be awarded for team places with the number of places determined by how many teams there are. Prize money will be divided equally between the two divisions. Skins will not be played in the tournament. Closest-to-the-pin competition for A-B-C-D players will be held each of the three days. Payment will be by check mailed shortly after the conclusion of the tournament. All Covid restrictions have ended in Texas some months ago. But the golf courses will require riding two to a cart because of cart availability. Scoring will be done after each round at the American Legion and the results posted.

The separate lady's tournament has been discontinued.

American Legion Post 626, 1125 Burton Hill Road, Ft Worth, TX 76114 will be tournament headquarters. Registration will be on Monday (September 19, 2022) and a Pork Chop Dinner / Social will also be on Monday at the American Legion with social time starting at 4:00 pm and dinner served at 5:00 pm. At the conclusion of the Hawks Creek round on Thursday afternoon, there will be an "After Tournament Social" with drinks, fried chicken, and heavy hors d'oeuvres at the American Legion. **Please support the American Legion.** Goulash available after golf on Tuesday and pulled pork on Wednesday.
